

### COVID-19

ICS Transportation Services will abide by the Province of Alberta Government, Alberta Education and Alberta Health Services guidelines and mandates.

#### Pre—ride

- Drivers and students must follow the self assessment questionnaire before driving or riding the bus each day.
- If a driver or student experience symptoms, they should not drive or ride and stay home.
- Drivers and students should perform hand hygiene prior to or upon entering the bus

#### Riding

- **Mandatory** masks for ALL drivers and students
  - In the event a driver notices a student regularly not wearing a mask, the driver will provide a verbal reminder. If non-compliance continues, the regular “Transportation Discipline” will be followed. A driver’s priority is safely operating the bus.
- **Mandatory** seating arrangements
  - The front 2 seats will be left open, where possible, for proper distancing for the driver and in a scenario a student is sick or shows COVID-19 symptoms and needs to be isolated.
    - In the scenario a student is sick or shows COVID symptoms, the driver will contact the school for the school to contact the parents/guardians to arrange pick up of the student.
  - Students will cohort by household up to 3 per seat if necessary. Where possible, physical distancing of 1 seat between cohorts may occur.
  - Students will load in their family cohort starting at the back of the bus first
  - Students will unload in their family cohort starting from the front of the bus first
  - Garbage cans on the bus will NOT be in use. Students must put any lunch/food waste back into their lunch kits.

#### Post—Ride

- Drivers will clean and disinfect their working area and high touch surfaces in the bus entry after each run.
- The remainder of the interior will be sanitized with an electro magnetic sprayer after the a.m. run or as needed.
- Additional deep cleaning can occur as required.
- Bus cleaning logs will be kept

#### Other

- **Transfer Only** will **NOT** be offered at this time
- NO bus passes will be given out at this time
- Loading and unloading procedures will be developed to support distancing where possible at each campus.
- ICES bus students will be let out at 3pm or 10 minutes prior the end of the day bell. From ICES, students who transfer to their home bus at ICSS, where possible, be paired with a classmate from their cohort.
- A limited number of non-medical masks will be available on each bus
